ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 105

DESIGNATING EUNICE BROYLES, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY,
DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA MINIMUM WAGE BOARD, AS AU-
THORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO GRANT OR DENY APPLI-
CATIONS FOR SPECIAL CERTIFICATES FOR THE EMPLOY-
MENT OF HANDICAPPED WORKERS, AND TO CANCEL SUCH
SPECIAL CERTIFICATES

By virtue of, and pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor, hereby designate Eunice Broyles, Executive Secretary, District of Columbia Minimum Wage Board, as my authorized representative, with full power and authority to grant or deny applications for special certificates for the employment of handicapped workers, and to sign, issue and cancel special certificates authorizing the employment of handicapped workers pursuant to the provisions of section 14 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 and Regulations, Title 29 -- Labor, Chapter V -- Wage and Hour Division, Part 524.
