HEARING ON 40-CENT WAGE FOR KNITTED AND MEN'S WOVEN UNDERWEAR
AND COMMERCIAL KNITTING POSTPONED TO SEPTEMBER 15

A public hearing on the 40-cent minimum wage recommended by the committee for the knitted and men's woven underwear and commercial knitting industry, originally announced for July 9, has been postponed to September 15, 1941, General Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, announced today.

The hearing will be held at 10 A.M. in Room 3229, Labor Department Building, before Henry T. Hunt, Principal Hearings Examiner for the Division. Any person interested in appearing at the hearing should file notice of his intention to appear with the Administrator not later than September 5.
