RESIGNATION AND REPLACEMENT

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF DATE OF CONVENING
OF INDUSTRY COMMITTEE FOR THE
RAILROAD AND PROPERTY CARRIER INDUSTRY
OF PUERTO RICO

By virtue of and pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended, I, Baird Snyder, Acting Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor,

- (1) hereby accept the resignation of Mr. William Homer Spencer as Chairman of the Industry Committee for the Railread and Property Carrier Industry of Puerto Rice, and appoint Mr. Arthur F. Raper, of Greensbore, Georgia, in his stead as Chairman of such committee; and
- (2) hereby postpone the date of the convening of the Industry Committee for the Rai Iroad and Property Carrier Industry of Puerto Rico from January 7, 1942, to January 8, 1942, at 9:30 A. M. The public hearing for the purpose of receiving evidence to be considered by this committee in recommending minimum wage rates consequently will also be postponed to January 8, 1942.
