NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE MINISUM WAGE RECOMMENDATION OF INDUSTRY COMMITTEE NO. 68 FOR THE FINANCE, INSURANCE, REAL ESTATE, MOTION PICTURE, AND MISCELLANEOUS INDUSTRIES

November 23 has been designated as the date on which a public hearing will be held to determine whether an industry committee recommendation of a minimum wage of 40 cents an hour for the Finance, Insurance, Real Estate, Motion Picture, and Miscellaneous Industries should be adopted.

This was announced today by L. Metcalfe Walling, Administrator, of the Wage and Hour and Public Contracts Divisions of the U. S.
