PUBLIC CONTRACTS ACT "RULINGS AND INTERPRETATIONS" IN NEW ISSUE
Issuance of Rulings and Interpretations No. 3, Walsh-Healey Public
Contracts Act, superseding all previously issued rulings and interpretations, was announced today by L. Metcalfe Walling, Administrator of the
Wage and Hour and Public Contracts Divisions, U. S. Department of Labor.

Most of the changes from Rulings and Interpretations No. 2 contained in the new edition are the result of the addition of the material contained in the Supplement to No. 2, issued January 24, 1944. In addition, several changes have been made, Mr. Walling said.

The Administrator pointed out that the newly issued pamphlet is "the only official compilation of interpretative material" on the Public Contracts Act. The practice of sending a copy of the pamphlet to every contractor who may be subject to the provisions of the Act will be continued as far as possible, he added.
