Conferences preliminary to the appointment of an industry committee or committees in the apparel field have been scheduled for the week of Oct. 17 by Administrator Elmer F. Andrews, of the Wage and Hour Division of the U.S. Labor Department.

Representatives of employers and employees have been invited to attend meetings on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of next week at which plans for appointment of the committee or committees will be discussed.

Administrator Andrews asked the advice of the industry leaders on the number of committees which should be appointed for the purpose of recommending the highest minimum wage for industries in the field under the requirements of the Act.

He also asked advice on what definitions should be used to limit and define the jurisdiction of the committee or committees so formed.

Branches of the industry to be represented at the conferences include: cotton garments, men's and boy's clothing, pants, women's dresses, infants and children's wear.
