
NOTICE OF ORAL ARGUMENT BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATOR AND OPPORTUNITY
TO SUBMIT WRITTEN BRIEFS IN THE MATTER OF THE RECOMMENDATION OF
INDUSTRY COMMITTEE NO. 16 FOR MINIMUM WAGES IN THE PORTABLE LAMP
AND SHADE INDUSTRY.

WHEREAS, notice was published in the Federal Register on December 19, 1940, stating that the Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division will receive written briefs on or before January 15, 1941, at the Department of Labor, Washington, D. C., from any person who entered an appearance at the hearing in the matter of the report and recommendation of Industry Committee No. 16 concerning minimum wage rates for the Portable Lamp and Shade Industry, and will hear oral argument upon the complete record of said hearing on January 27, 1941, at 10 A.M., at Room 3229, Department of Labor Building, Fourteenth Street and Constitution Avenue, Washington, D. C., by any person who entered an appearance at said hearing, provided that on or before January 15, 1941, such person notifies the Wage and Hour Division of his intention to offer oral argument and of the amount of time he will require to make his presentation, and

WHEREAS, interested persons have requested a postponement of the final date for filing briefs in said matter,

NOW, THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that the Administrator will receive written briefs (not fewer than twelve copies) on or before January 22, 1941, at the Department of Labor, Washington, D. C., from any person who entered an appearance at said hearing, and will hear oral argument upon the complete record of said hearing on January 27, 1941, at 10 A.M., at Room 3229, Department of Labor Building, Fourteenth Street and Constitution Avenue, Washington, D. C., by any person who entered an appearance at said hearing, provided that on or before January 22, 1941, such person notifies the Wage and Hour Division of his intention to offer oral argument and of the amount of time he will require to make his presentation.
