JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives 1 of the United States of America in Congress assembled 2 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein). That the 3 following article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-4 stitution of the United States. which, when ratified by the $\overline{\mathbf{5}}$ legislatures of three-fourths of the several States, shall be 6 valid to all intents and purposes as a part of the Constitution: 7 "ARTICLE —. 8

9 "SECTION 1. The Congress shall have power to limit, 10 regulate, and prohibit the labor of persons under eighteen 11 years of age. "SEC. 2. The power of the several States is unimpaired
by this article except that the operation of State laws shall
be suspended to the extent necessary to give effect to legislation enacted by the Congress."
