2 out the colon and insert a comma and the following words:
3 "or any article or commodity the product of any farm
4 which is the material for the product of any mill, cannery,
5 workshop, factory, or manufacturing establishment in the
6 United States upon which children under the age of fourteen
7 years have been employed or permitted to work or children
8 between the ages of fourteen and sixteen years have been
9 employed or permitted to work more than eleven hours a
10 day."
