Mr. CELLER submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That the Committee on Rules is hereby
2 directed to make an investigation of the economic effect on
3 Negro industrial workers of codes of fair competition formu-
4 lated under title I of the National Industrial Recovery Act,
5 in order to ascertain whether the labor provisions of such
6 codes do discriminate against Negro workers and whether
7 the actual effect of the provisions of such codes react dis-
8 advantageously to Negro industrial workers.

9 Such investigation shall include a study of any of the
10 activities of the National Recovery Administration bearing
11 upon this subject, including the activities of the Labor Ad-
12 visory Board, the National Compliance Board, and the
13 Consumers' Advisory Board.
