SUBJECT: Travel of Attorneys

In order that the General Counsel may be able to reach any one on his staff at any time, attorneys shall, in all instances, advise him whenever official travel is anticipated. Itineraries should be furnished as far in advance as possible, indicating addresses at each point. Should it be necessary to deviate from the itinerary submitted, the General Counsel should be advised specifically of the changes and temporary addresses.
